Billy Lynn Sprinkle, age 57, of Hiddenite, passed away, Saturday, October 8th, 2016 at Iredell Memorial Hospital, Statesville. Billy was born September 4th, 1959 in Alexander County, to the late James Haskell Sprinkle and Katherine Sloan Sprinkle who survives.

Billy was a self-employed poultry farmer and was very active in his community and Alexander County. He served as chairman of the Alexander County Democratic Party for a number of years and was a member of the Gwaltney Ruritan Club, was a referee for the N.C. Volleyball Association, and was manager of the East Alexander County Pool Association.
