



## Coyet Newton Wyatt

July 11, 1918 - November 21, 2012

Coyet Newton Wyatt, age 94 of the Cool Spring Community, Statesville, left this earth to go to his heavenly home Wednesday November 21, 2012 at Davis Regional Medical Center, unexpectedly.
