What's really sad is that bad things happen to good people. That's what happened to you.

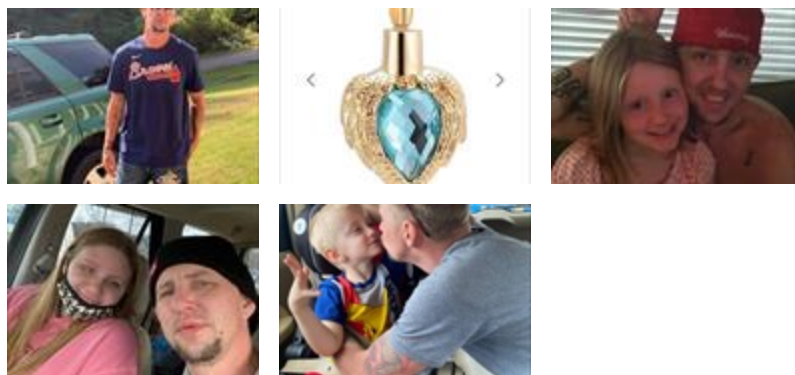
I'm sure you knew I loved you. And I know you loved me.
