George DeLauder, 95, passed away peacefully on June, 26, 2016 at his home in Stony Point, NC. He was born on February 25, 1921 and grew up in the Toledo, OH area. He enlisted in the Air Force during WW II and was deployed overseas to Italy. After serving his country, he returned to Toledo where he had a long career as the maintenance leader at Surface Combustion. He was also a member of the Masonic Temple and the Toledo Roadrunners camp club. He and his wife Rose traveled the country in their motorhome.

Upon retirement, he relocated to Stony Point, NC and maintained a small engine repair service out of his home for many years until his wife's health issues forced him to close. He was a member of the Stony Point Methodist Church and belonged to the Hiddenite Emerald Squares dance group until his bad knee forced him to step down.

He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, Amelia Rose DeLauder and son, Ronald Jeffery DeLauder. He is survived by sisters-in-law, Lillian Murphy of Oregon, OH and Donna Pitock of Flint, MI and numerous nieces and nephews.
