



## Mildred Maxine Jenkins Miller

March 13, 1932 - August 20, 2011

Mildred Maxine Jenkins Miller, age 79 of Stony Point, passed away Saturday August 20, 2011 at Gordon Hospice House, after extended illness. She was born March 13, 1932 in Iredell County to the late Carroll Lee Jenkins and Pernia Cornelia Sharpe Jenkins. Mrs. Miller was a noted genealogist and local historian. She was a long time member and former President of the Genealogical Society of Iredell County and worked for years in the office of the Genealogy and Historic Properties Commission which is the official office of the Society.

Mrs. Miller has helped in the preservation of Iredell County history through her writings and her assistance to researchers. She was also a member of New Amity ARP Church where she had served many years as a Sunday school teacher, coordinator of the Elderteens and wrote the church history.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, John Jackson Miller; a brother, Larry Jenkins; a great granddaughter, Alley Campbell; a half brother, William T. Jenkins; and a step sister, Sarah Jenkins. She is survived by one son, David Miller and wife Nancy; one daughter, Sandra Blevins and husband Bill; a sister, Sylvia Snider; a sister in law, Betty Jenkins; five grandchildren, Ben Blevins, Katy Campbell, Jennifer Winebarger, Travis Bailey, and Melissa Nowlin; and six great grandchildren all of Stony Point.

Funeral services will be conducted at 3:00pm Tuesday August 23, 2011 at New Amity ARP Church. The body will lie in state thirty minutes prior to the

funeral hour. Rev. Chris Parnell and Rev. Marion Swann will officiate. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends following the burial at the church.
