Master Sergeant (Retired) Morris McDonald Greene age 84, of Bethlehem, passed away, Sunday, November 13th, 2016 at Novant Health Rowan, Salisbury. Morris was born February 28th, 1932 in Mitchell County, to the late Horace and Belle Buchanan Greene.
