Moselle Ball Watts, 94, of 894 West Main Ave., Taylorsville, passed away, Wednesday November 19, 2008 at Valley Nursing Center. She was born September 4, 1914, in Alexander County to the late Amos Franklin "A.F." Ball and Lettie Lee Chamberlain Ball. She was a graduate of Stony Point High School. She received her BS degree from Appalachian State Teachers College and her Masters degree in Math and Science from George Peabody College in Tennessee. She was a School Teacher 42 years.

She taught at Wingate Junior College, Taylorsville High School, Hiddenite High School, and Alexander Central before retiring in 1978. In 2000 she was a recipient of the Alexander County Schools Award of Honor. A member of First Baptist Church in Taylorsville and a Sunday School Teacher for 50 Years.
