



Robert Lewis McKittrick

May 3, 1922 - January 13, 2011

Robert Lewis McKittrick, age 88 of 150 Circle Loop, Stony Point, passed away Thursday January 13, 2011 at Iredell Memorial Hospital. He had been in declining health for a number of years and critically ill for two days. He was born May 3, 1922 in Mountville, SC to the late James Asa McKittrick and Nettie Johnson McKittrick.

Mr. McKittrick was a graduate of the University of South Carolina, School of Pharmacy where he was the recipient of the Merck Award which at the time was awarded to the outstanding pharmacy graduate. Mr. McKittrick also served in the US Navy during WWII in the Pacific and was recalled to active duty during the Korean War. He owned and operated Mack's Pharmacy in Stony Point for thirty-five years. He was a Ruritan Citizen of the year in 1989, a Mason and Shriner, and also a member of Stony Point Baptist Church where he was active as long as health permitted. He served as deacon, treasurer and on various committees.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by four brothers, William McKittrick, Kenneth McKittrick, James McKittrick and Harold McKittrick; one sister, Alice McKittrick Mansfield.

He is survived by his wife of sixty-two years, Ruth Timmerman McKittrick of the home; one son, Tim McKittrick of Stony Point; one brother, Charles McKittrick and wife Betty of Greenville, SC; a number of nephews and nieces. Funeral services will be conducted 3:00pm Sunday at Stony Point Baptist Church. Rev. Phil Addison and Rev. Henry Cook will officiate. Burial will follow

in the Stony Point Cemetery. The family will receive friends from 2:00-3:00pm
Sunday prior to the service at the church
